Dear Paul,

I have had the opportunity to confer with Bishop Manning this morning.

We are instructed to request that the following documents not be provided to The Hon.A Whitlam QC :

1. The letter from Bishop Manning to me dated 19 May 2004 with my handwritten note - a clean copy from the Parramatta Diocese file dated 19 May may be provided instead (on the basis that the handwritten note is a privileged communication between the Bishop and me; it contains second hand information which may be unreliable);
2. The chronology which I prepared for the purposes of defending the CPK matter (on the basis that it represents my possibly inaccurate summary of various documents referred to in the CPK matter; is a gloss on those documents prepared for a different purpose and may therefore be unreliable; the source documents should be obtained for the purposes of the Inquiry and relied upon - those documents will speak for themselves).

Bishop Manning has no objection to the other documents from the Parramatta file involving CPK which I handed to you to be made available to the Inquiry.
