6. I am handling a case of sexual abuse accusation against a high profile A.O.G. pastor that at times gives me stress, especially when the evangelist to whom the mother confided tells me I am sweeping the matter under the carpet.

I am trying to proceed at the pace of the victim's emotions which because of delayed response by the perpetrator for healing and restoration has reached a place that he feels he cannot go further (at the moment). I have told him if he goes to the secular courts I will not stand with him but if he goes to the church I will. I am convinced in my spirit the crime was committed albeit 30 years ago.

The evangelist went to a State Executive Member. I have followed through letting him know of each step taken to try to resolve this matter. At my last meeting he has said something is needed in writing and the matter will then be investigated by the A.O.G.

I have kept a record of my, the victim's and the perpetrators involvement in this matter as far as I am concerned. I content my self that we must proceed at the pace of the victim who as a child was powerless but now has the power.

However I must confess I feel at times stressed. The evangelist rang me in the States when I was there recently on a preaching trip. He recently rang me still reiterating I and the AOG are scared and that I in particular am "sweeping the matter under the carpet". He says not a day passes but that he thinks of this matter and says it will never be resolved by the AOG.
