**Member of the General Synod Board of Ministry and Training**, 1982-92, a body charged with reviewing the training of clergy and lay people working in the Church. My particular area of responsibility was the work of Examining Chaplains (those with responsibility for selection and training of clergy in the various dioceses), which led to regular national conferences.

**Member of the General Board of Religious Education (GBRE) 1978-89,** and a member of the Executive Committee, 1979-89. My particular areas of interest and achievement were youth work and adult education. I was for many years a Mentor in the Education for Ministry Program developed by the University of Sewanee, USA, introduced in Australia by GBRE.

**Examining Chaplain to the Bishop of Tasmania 1983-1994,** with particular responsibility for those ordination candidates in training. During this time the whole programme of selection and training was restructured and a set of policies developed.

**Member of the Diocesan Council of the Diocese of Tasmania, 1982-1994,** including membership of many committees and task groups involved in management and policy development in the life of the Church. As an Archdeacon for five years I have been expected to exercise a wide range of leadership roles across the Church in Tasmania, and particularly in the Synod.

**Member of the Diocesan Education Committee, 1968-1994,** including five years on the staff of the Diocese as Youth and Education Officer, during which time I pioneered the Youth Synod model and saw it spread across the Anglican Church in Australia.

**Foundation Chairperson of the Deloraine Community Centre, 1986-88,** a successful community based initiative that has gone on to become a significant part of the local scene in that rural town.

**Foundation Chairperson of the Tasmanian Youth Affairs Council, 1980-81,** during which time the Youth Affairs Council of Australia was struggling to reform itself.

**Contributor to the Australian Dictionary of Biography -** Bishop R.S.Hay, Bishop G.F.Cranswick, and Archdeacon F.Whittington.
