NOTE FROM BOTTOM OF LETTER ("Aborigines Inland Mission"  
of 4th January, 1956.)

MR. MILLIKEN

There are several matters in this letter which I would like to discuss with you urgently:-

- (1) The question of corporal punishment of wards placed in this Institution.
- (2) The problem of alternative accommodation for children at Retta Dixon (and particularly the teenagers)

2. On the second point I propose to have Sister Eileen investigate and report on the functions and possible future responsibilities of these institutions in the light of our accepted policy for accommodation of children in the South and the possible entry into this field of the Salvation Army.

3. On the first point I propose to find out precisely where I stand legally in respect of corporal punishment of wards and possible delegation for their care and welfare to the Superintendent of this Institution.
