Application for Approval.

With reference to the application by the abovenamed Mission for recognition as an Institution under the Social Services Consolidation Act, the following particulars were obtained from a representative of the Department of Native Affairs.

The Mission is not situated on the Aboriginal Reserve at Darwin, the property is either owned by the Mission or is held on lease.

The inmates are under the care, custody, and control of the Mission and the Superintendent sees that the children are properly housed, fed and educated, and that they receive medical treatment.

No further information concerning the maintenance etc. provided by the parents of the inmates other than that given by Miss Shankelton in her recent letter which accompanied the application.
