Event constituting Child abuse or sexual misconduct	\$
<p>Category 1: Harassment constituting child abuse or sexual misconduct; Indecent act, assault or indecent assault; Assault with violence or assault in the course of attempted unlawful sexual intercourse; Sexual misconduct in a pastoral relationship; or Physical assault.</p>	Up to 15,000
<p>Category 2: An unlawful act of sexual intercourse; or Infliction of serious bodily injury in the course of an attempted act of unlawful sexual intercourse.</p>	Up to 35,000
<p>Category 3: A sustained pattern of child abuse or sexual misconduct involving category 1 or category 2 harassment, assault, or sexual assault; Assault or unlawful sexual intercourse in which serious bodily injury is inflicted; Assault or unlawful sexual intercourse in which 2 or more offenders are involved; or Assault or unlawful sexual intercourse in which the offender uses an offensive weapon.</p>	Up to 75,000
Effects arising from child abuse or sexual misconduct	
<p>Psychological or psychiatric disorder: Category A, chronic psychological or psychiatric disorder that is moderately disabling i.e. affects lifestyle and relationships.</p>	Up to 22,500
<p>Psychological or psychiatric disorder: Category B, chronic psychological or psychiatric disorder that is severely disabling i.e. on its own prevents employment.</p>	Up to 75,000
