Further to my telephone call to you I now write to confirm the offer to you of the position of Rector of the Parish of Burnie.

The stipend offered is the Diocesan minimum for a Rector plus 20%. In addition there is a travelling allowance paid according to the Diocesan Scale.

A rectory is provided free of all charges and the parish pays the rental of telephone and parish calls. In addition the parish meets half the cost of heat, light and power as required by the Parish Administration Ordinance.

A copy of the information supplied to the Patronage Council is enclosed. It may well be that in trying to reach a decision you will need further information. May I suggest that all negotiations relevant to reaching a decision should take place through the Archdeacon of the area, viz. Archdeacon Warburton. He will be able to arrange for you to see the rectory, for example, and to meet with the Wardens should you desire that.

Be assured that my prayers will be with you as you wrestle with the invitation. May God bless and guide you.
