Dear Steve,

I advise you that a Diocesan Tribunal met today to commence hearing charges laid against the Reverend Garth Hawkins following complaints made by you last year.

Mr Robert Mackay has been appointed to promote the case for the Diocese. I understand Mr Mackay has been in contact with you to discuss your involvement as he sees necessary. I hope that you are able to co-operate as Mr Mackay requests.

I realise that you are unhappy with the length of time taken to reach this point. I can understand that and apologise on behalf of those concerned. The delays were due to circumstances beyond the control of the Anglican Church and its officers, but I appreciate that this may have caused you more concern than otherwise would have been the case.

You are urged to maintain contact with your support persons during this time and you are assured of my prayers as the Tribunal meets and carries out its task.
