Dear Sir,

In response to your letter of 26 May 2004, can I make the following points.

1. I was living interstate in 1975. I returned in late November and worked in the parish of Moonah. I lived in Lutana until early 1977, when I moved to Glenorchy. If what he is telling you is the same as he told the Police years ago, he claims these things happened at Glenorchy.
2. To the best of my recollection, I encountered Gould through youth work about 1978 or 1979. It was about the time his mother died, if you can determine that.
3. I have no memory of any trip to the Derwent Valley in 1975 or any other time.

I realise that nothing I say has any credibility, but these are verifiable facts, and may help.
