GREETING,—We do by these presents give and grant to you our LICENCE and AUTHORITY to Preach the Word of God, Read the Common Prayers, and perform all other Ministerial Duties belonging to the Office of an Assistant Priest of the Church of England in the Parish of St. George, Invermay, within our Diocese and Jurisdiction, on the nomination of the Reverend J. A. Senior, according to the form prescribed in the Book of Common Prayer of the Church of England, and not otherwise or in any other manner, you having first before us taken the Oaths and made and subscribed the Declaration which in this case are required by Law to be taken, made, and subscribed; reserving to us, and our successors the power to revoke at pleasure this Licence and Authority.

In Witness Whereof we have caused our Episcopal Seal to be affixed to these presents this 24th day of February in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and Seventy-three and in the 13th Year of our Consecration.
