Michael

Option 1

Ask the Bishop to table it at the next DC meeting (23/8/12). This will be the last DC meeting before the synod business paper goes to print. DC would need to consider it and refer it to synod. There are other amendments listed for discussion about the Professional Standards Ordinance that night so I would imagine that your request is reasonable because of that. Should the DC not consent, it would not be referred to synod (see option 3 below)

Option 2

A member of Synod can raise this amendment on the floor of Synod when the Williams/Stuart Ordinance is being discussed and debate the reasons for amending Section 70

Option 3

Synod Standing Order 49 states

"Any member who wishes to bring before the Synod a Bill to whose introduction the Diocesan council has not consented, shall send a draft to the Diocesan Business Manager not less than 8 weeks before the first day of the session of synod with a written undertaking to pay the cost of the printing, and the first reading should then be entered on the business paper. Should the bill pass the synod, then the cost of the printing shall be defrayed by the Diocesan council"

Synod commences on the 27th October therefore , 8 weeks + 1 day prior is the 31/8/12
