The Professional Standards Board held hearings in Newcastle last week that involved five respondents. The Board dealt with allegations from a complainant and found the allegations upheld.

The Professional Standards Board has made recommendations to me as the Bishop.

Subsequently, an injunction was taken out in and granted by the Supreme Court of New South Wales inhibiting me from acting on the recommendations.

The injunction is returnable in early February 2011.

The matters rest until the Supreme Court decides upon the substance of the injunction. I have agreed not to act on the recommendations in the interim.

I am grateful that at this time I have advice from the Acting Chancellor, Mr Justice Young and the Acting Deputy Chancellor, His Honour Judge Chris Armitage.
