11.1 A BILL FOR A CHURCH TRUST PROPERTY ORDINANCE 2012

The debate resumed into Committee
The Chairman of Committees reported its resolution

"That the bill for a 'Church Trust Property Ordinance 2012' as amended be adopted" Carried

"That 'The Diocesan Council either amend the Professional Standards Ordinance to insert a section equivalent to (the deleted) PART 8(a) dealing with complaints against the Director or Members of the Professional Standards Committee or include this in the protocol.'" Carried

14.1 2013 Diocesan Ministry Budget

The Venerable Stephen Pullin moved:

The Reverend Canon Katherine Bowyer moved:

"That the proposed Missionary Targets for 2013 as tabled before this Synod within the supplementary list be approved."

15. GENERAL MOTIONS

15.1 The Reverend Jess Grant moved:

"That this Synod:

- a) Give thanks to God for the ministry of Dr Rowan Williams, Archbishop of Canterbury for his wise and gracious leadership of the Anglican Communion over the past decade;
- b) Acknowledges the Archbishop's perseverance and patience in calling the Anglican Communion to respectful dialogue and greater unity in difficult and diverse times, and
- c) Assures the Archbishop of Canterbury of the prayers and good wishes of this Diocese on his retirement from the position and his return to academic life."

15.2 Mrs Noelene Lentfer moved:

"That this synod:

1. Notes the expansive wording of clause 81 (d) of the Administration of Parishes Ordinance, 2010, which refers to money received "requiring payment to mission agencies" without specifying the types of mission agencies covered by this ordinance.
2. Recognises that parishioners and visitors give money to parishes for a variety of mission agencies with the expectation that (a) the whole amount of money given goes to the mission agency and (b) that such giving does not burden the parish beyond, perhaps, the cost of a stamp.
