
REPORT FOR THE SEXUAL HARASSMENT FILE

On Wednesday, 24th April, just prior to 7pm, I was telephoned by a man who claimed he wished to talk about an incident of sexual abuse which he said had happened to him and another boy in the Mount Sugarloaf Anglican Parish in 1970. He said that the incident had been brought back to his mind by the current publicity given to sexual abuse matters in respect of a Roman Catholic priest. I asked him, was this allegation made against an Anglican Priest and he affirmed that it was.

I advised him that the Diocese of Newcastle had clear sexual harassment guidelines and that I would be glad to make these available to him. He said, "I am not looking for legal redress but I do need help." I suggested that he might come to see me. Up to this point he had not given a name. He said he was dubious about coming to see me as he felt it might be "like an inquisition". I assured him that this was not the case. He then told me that his name was CKA. He agreed that he would come to see me on Saturday, 27th April at 9am in my office at REDACTED. He did not come to the arranged interview or make any further contact. I was in my office all morning.
