and Receive Sentence**

*(After Conviction in the District Court)*

in the State of New South Wales (hereinafter called the offender) personally came before me, the undersigned, one of Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace for the said State, and acknowledged himself to owe to Our Sovereign Lady the Queen the sum following (that is to say): the said offender the sum of

one hundred

dollars

of good and lawful money, to be made and levied of his goods and chattels land and tenements to the use of Our said Lady the Queen, Her Heirs and Successors, if he the said offender shall fail in the conditions indorsed hereunder.


The conditions of the within-written Recognizance are such, that whereas the offender was on the 7th day of September, 1990, at the sitting of the District Court of New South Wales at Gosford convicted before McGuire, D.C.J. Judge, of the offence of Homosexual Intercourse with male between 10 & 18 years and was thereafter for his said offence duly ordered to enter into a Recognizance in the sum of

one hundred

dollars

conditioned that the said offender do be of good behaviour during the period of three years from this date and do appear at the said Court at Gosford or at such other place as may be appointed within the said State to receive sentence in respect of the said offence at any time in respect of any breach within the said period if called upon to do so by notice which may be sent by registered post to the offender at the address above-mentioned or to such other addresses as he may notify in writing to the Clerk of the Peace.

If, therefore, the said offender do be of good behaviour within the said period and do otherwise comply with the conditions of this recognizance and do appear at the said Court at Gosford aforesaid, or at such other place as may be appointed to receive sentence in respect of the said offence, if called upon to do so, then this Recognizance to be void, or else to stand in full force and virtue.
