My Dear Father,

As requested by the Archdeacon I write to accept the position as Priest of the experimental Area of Gateshead.

I would with respect suggest that the announcement of the appointment be made after Sunday 9th March as I have been invited to Gateshead to preach on that night and it may cause embarrassment to Gordon, however I am sure that I ^{can} get out of that engagement if you think it wise.
