Subject Allegations of misconduct

I spoke to Joanne McLean at DOCS on her private line REDACTED about allegations against a former student at College --allegations which had originally been suspected in 1999.

The child concerned now wishes to take matters further and +Roger asked me to talk to Joanne as to the process.

Joanne outlined the following steps, saying that either the Bishop or the mother could follow them:

- ⊕ ring Help Line on 132111
- ⊕ Give Info to them:
 - details of the child - name, dob, address, etc.
 - the child's story
 - what the child wants to do now.

Joanne explained that there may be some delay on the Help Line, it being a call centre. She added that if there is any breakdown in the process she'd be happy to talk again.

I spoke to ^{CKR} on her mobile around 12.15 today, 20 May and outlined the above. She agreed that it would be better if she made the phone call rather than the Bishop. I agreed to email her the outline above as she was calling from her car.

We discussed her making an appointment with the Bishop and she said she would ring back once she had spoken with the Help Line.
