Dear Bishop Holland,

I refer to my meeting with you, Reverend A. Bridge and the

 Assistant at REDACTED Anglican Church.

I reserve the right to disagree with you that my resignation
 is in the best interests of the Parish of REDACTED.

I find it a bitter thing to reconcile myself to the fact that,
 after thirty years of devoted service to REDACTED Anglican Church, anyone
 in this Parish could bring themselves to think that I would be dishonest.

After the events of the last three months, I will find great
 difficulty in ever again worshipping in an Anglican Church.
