### Purpose

Mr Simon Antony JACOBS – provide information as to the leadership roles of Mr Jacobs

### Background

I've reviewed Mr Simon JACOBS CEBS Leaders Card for the purposes of providing factual information for your use with Media following Mr Jacobs pleading guilty last Friday 03/12/2010 to child sexual abuse charges.

I understand from the lead Police Detective that Mr Jacobs pleaded guilty in the Downing Centre District Court. (Not for release – Further, that he made admissions to Police after his Court hearing that may result in another 6 charges concerning two more victims.)

However ,Mr Jacobs is now scheduled to appear in the same court for sentence on the four charges on 04/03/2011.

1971	Assistant Page Leader	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• BYC's court statement shows this to be at St Ives.</li> <li>• I believe this is the second youngest age group of boys in CEBS. Usually 8 to 11 years old.</li> </ul>
Aug-1971	Warrant Issued	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mr Jacobs Leader's Warrant and indicates the date he qualified as a CEBS Page Leader.</li> </ul>
1971	Page Leader	
1977	Page Leader	
1978 – St Ives	Assistant Esquire Leader	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• First card entry confirming appointment at St Ives.</li> <li>• Also his appointment to the next older age group of CEBS. Usually 12 to 14 years old.</li> </ul>
1979	Assistant Esquire Leader	
1980 - 1981	Esquire Leader	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Although abbreviated on the card this appears to be a promotion from Assistant to Leader.</li> <li>• BYC's court statement places them both in Esquires at St Ives by December 1980.</li> </ul>
1982 – 1984	{Indecipherable} -	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This is the only record of Mr Jacobs</li> </ul>

	Not to be issued with Ldr's Wrt	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>These notes are from the Leaders Card Comments section are undated. They suggest that either after transfer from St Ives or possibly after leaving Pymble this entry was made.</i></li> <li>• <i>The Leader's Warrant had to be reauthorised and reissued on transfer from a Parish. Also a Rector or a tribunal could revoke a leader's warrant. A collection of other sources of information suggest that his warrant was revoked in 1981 or 1982.</i></li> <li>• <i>Further this collection of other papers indicates that Pymble was short of a CEBS leader at the time Simon Jacobs joined them.</i></li> </ul>

**Summary.**

Mr S Jacobs served as a CEBS Leader in various roles from 1971 to 1981 at St Ives Anglican Church. I also understand that he was in a leadership role at Pymble Anglican Church from 1982 to 1984.
