Dear Bishop,

Your letter of the 5 June arrived last night.

Yes, I would hope to continue as a member of the congregation at **REDACT** where I have been a member since 1994. I joined there immediately after leaving Tasmania, as my brother is a long term member there, and the rector at that time was an old friend. The rector and church wardens were aware of my situation. I found **REDACT** to be a most welcoming and supportive congregation, right through the six months I was in prison in 1999 until I left for this spell in jail in 2005. I have been in regular contact since both with the parish and with a number of members of the congregation.

I worshipped regularly at the 8 am service, and would hope to resume that practice. It is not my intention to be involved in any other parish activities.

I am prepared to be part of your process and would be happy to meet with the Rev'd Peter Barnett. I question the expense of him coming to Hobart to see me as I will be back in Canberra about the 5th August. If he does decide to come down I suggest he liaise with the chaplain here, the Rev'd **REDACT**. He needs to make sure that he comes when I am available to see him.
