Interim Safety Agreement 2012

REGARDING THE INVOLVEMENT OF Mr L Daniels at [REDACTED]

This Interim Safety agreement records the conditions upon which Mr Daniels agrees to abide by, in order to worship at [REDACTED] whilst risk assessment is completed and an Individual Safety Agreement is developed.

This Interim Safety Agreement begins August 2012 and will be reviewed in November 2012.

1 ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

Mr Daniels acknowledges that he has committed sexual offenses against minors (under 16), and remains a risk to minors.

It is acknowledged by all parties that the needs and safety of the parish are to be considered and put first at all times.

The Diocese acknowledges the need for care, nurture and the ongoing spiritual life of Mr Daniels.

Mr [REDACTED] has agreed to be the Church contact and liaison person with the Diocesan Safe Ministries Unit for this period.

2. Interim Safety measures

Mr Daniels may:

- 2.1 attend the 8am service, as long as one of his Interim Support Group is with him 'eyes on' at all times he is on any of the church's premises.
- 2.2 attend social events, drop his mother off at mid-week events (with his brother) etc with the condition that he does not make contact with minors at these events, and that at least one member of his Interim Support Group is with him 'eyes on' at all times he is on any of the church's premises.
- 2.3 NOT to volunteer for nor attend in any Parish activities or programs where children or youth are the focus, without prior agreement/approval from the Safe Ministries Unit representative and in the "eyes on" presence of an appointed member of his Accountability Group.
- 2.4 NOT to accept nomination for election to any leadership office within the Parish or wider church.
- 2.5 not come onto church property without another non-family adult, and not at times midweek when children's programs are occurring
- 2.6 not initiate conversations with or touch, minors from the parish at anytime, e.g. in town (offsite)

3 COMMITMENT OF THE Interim Support Group.

- 3.1 The Support Group commits itself to provide a roster to provide monitoring and support to Mr Daniels.
- 3.2 The Support group will be on a roster for "eyes on" contact at all times Mr Daniels is on church premise when children are present and also at organised parish events offsite.

4 DISCLOSURE


This agreement will be kept confidential except as follows:

- 4.1 Mr Daniels understands that the details of this of agreement will be discussed with Parish Council.
- 4.2 Mr Daniels understands that the Safe Ministries Unit representative may disclose this agreement to any organisation or person, within or outside of the Parish, where he/she considers that it is necessary to ensure the welfare and safety of any person.
- 4.3 Mr Daniels understands that if he breaches any condition of this agreement Mr Robert Arthur will contact the Safe Ministries Unit Representative.
- 4.5 The disclosure can be either verbal or by providing a copy of this agreement by the Safe Ministries Unit Representative.

5 CESSATION OF INVOLVEMENT

- 5.1.1 If Mr Daniels wishes to leave this Parish and the Parish Council or diocese finds that he is attending another church, the leaders of that church will be informed of this agreement.
- 5.1.2 If Mr Daniels breaches any provision of this interim safety agreement he will not be permitted to attend in any Parish activity until a meeting with the Safe Ministries Unit representative is held.
- 5.1.3 If Mr Daniels informs the parish he wishes to cease to be involved in the life of the Parish (or lapses in attendance for more than 6 months) or breaches any part of this agreement becomes null and void and Mr REDACTED will notify the Safe Ministries Unit representative.
