Seeks response regarding outcome of investigation, future of Harrowgate site and McGlennon's employment status. No issue of paedophilic allegations raised. No issue of refusal by Menses to see McGlennon referred to.	no
11.	24 June	Memo from Menses to Bleby attaching above document. "this	no

memo does not accord with my understanding of the conversation you reported with him, nor my request to you to convey to him the outcomes of the investigation". Notes McGlennon to be managed in future by Hartwig. No reference is made to a "second report", separate investigation or allegation by McGlennon of paedophilic activities – such a reference would necessarily have been expected if these events had occurred.
