Dear Rosemary,

I had an extensive pastoral interview with **CKR** yesterday.

During the course of this interview **CKR** said that she felt that she had been abused by the Diocese in the whole process of the dealing with her complaint against Ian Barrack. I responded to her that as she had said to me that she felt abused psychologically and spiritually by the Diocese (that is certain senior clergy of the Diocese) that I must advise her to contact you as her contact person and report that sense of abuse.

I felt it my duty to respond to **CKR** in terms of the Protocol and the Canon.

Second, there is a series of questions that **CKR** wishes answered in order to gain closure of this whole protracted affair. These questions came to her during the recent retreat.

She read some of them to me and again my advice to **CKR** was that she raise these questions with you for they may need to be referred to the Professional Standards Committee as indeed will her sense of having been abused.

CKR expressed her gratitude about your support and about my own care of her and that fact that at an earlier interview I had said how sorry I was that she had endured what she had endured. That saying of 'sorry' was very significant to her.

I commend **CKR** to your continuing care.
