

Things that must be ^{addressed} faced by Grafton

1. Tommy wants an explanation of Grafton's conclusion about who had duty of care for the children in the home.

Tom Blackburn has raised questions about the reliability of the deed of settlement because of the absence of agency agreements between certain parties and those who executed the deed. If there is a deficit in this respect should it not be addressed proactively and corrected..?
