NOTE.—(1) Regulation 39 (2) provides that where the application is in respect of a place in which more than five children are to be reared, nursed or maintained apart from their mother or other parent:

This application shall be accompanied by a report furnished by a qualified medical practitioner attached to the establishment covering:

- (i) The sanitary condition of the establishment; and
- (ii) The provision made for accommodation (cots, bedding, etc.); and
- (iii) Any inmate suffering from any infectious or contagious disease, especially of the eyes, ears or skin; and
- (iv) The provision made for the nursing, feeding, clothing and medical aid of any infant received apart from its parents.

(2) Persons making such application should note that they have to make their own arrangements regarding remuneration with the person placing the child in their care, and that no responsibility rests on the Minister for payment.
