RE: NORTH COAST CHILDREN'S HOME

As discussed this morning, Mr Peter Roland of Foott Law and Co, Solicitors, Grafton, (phone no: 66421900) will shortly brief you on providing general and tactical advice in the matter of potentially 42 claimants against the Church as a consequence of their former residency at the North Coast Children's Home.

As a matter of convenience and to add speed to the process, I have offered to provide you with the necessary major documents.

8. Statement and two letters concerning possible comments re this matter in the Northern Star. The written comments were prepared at the request of a Northern Star journalist who informed me he had been talking to Richard Campion and did I have anything to say?

It is the wish of the Church that matters concerning the limitations, the identity of the proposed defendant, ownership of the Home in terms of any vicarious or non-delegable duty of care and the question of whether the Church actually in these circumstances owed a duty to these possible claimants should be resolved prior to consideration of the detail of the individual claimants.

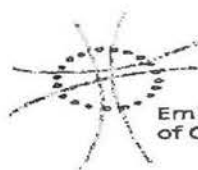
Your arrival is obviously eagerly awaited.
