Dear Barry

I would like to write clarifying two issues in my letter to you of 18 May 1999.

In the paragraph under Point 1, I indicate that Anglicare SA has been responsible for the management of the sites that were once entrusted to various Diocesan bodies. I realise that the wording in this paragraph is ambiguous. I am not suggesting that Anglican Community Services (Anglicare SA) has been responsible for the running of the campsites since the 1950s. I was indicating that the bodies that were responsible for the campsites no longer have a separate existence. The precise chronology is as follows:

- The Diocesan Campsites Committee began in 1982 and undertook responsibility for management of the campsites previously looked after by other bodies.
- Anglican Community Services, now Anglicare SA, took over responsibility for the campsites in 1989, managing them as part of its own operations.

The second point of clarification relates to Point 2 and the dates of employment by Anglicare SA of Bob Brandenburg. It is stated in the letter of 18 May 1999 that Bob began work with us on 1st October 1981. In fact, that is the date from which he was employed by the Diocese of Adelaide. Hence his leave entitlements and history of employment dates from then. In fact Bob became an employee of Anglican Community Services on 21st January 1989 and remained with us until 25th June 1997. The confusion about the starting date arose over our records tracing his entitlements back to October 1981.

I hope this clarifies the matter.
