

Dear Sir,

We refer to your letter dated 25 October 2001 relating to claims by ex students of St Paul's School.

We now refer to the attachment to that letter marked Appendix "A".

Point 2.

The room referred to as a tearoom was actually an office used by the Chaplain until the end of 1999 and when the office was vacated by the Chaplain, a doorway was cut into the adjoining wall and a one-third glass door installed to give access for the Student Counsellor to use the room as an office. This work was performed by the School's maintenance carpenter.

With reference to the replacement of the coloured glass in the stairway leading to the Counsellor's office this was replaced in September 1995. In fact the opaque glass was replaced as that particular type and colour of glass was no longer available and therefore the School could not replace the panes as they cracked or were broken.

A copy of the official School Order made out to Northside Glass and Glazing is attached to this letter.

The three way light indicator was removed by maintenance staff at the end of 1999 when the Counsellor's Office was relocated to another building and the room used as a teachers' staff room.

Point 3

3.1.1.1 We enclose a copy of the floor plan of the building as designed by architects Conrad, Gargett & Partners, Drawing no. WD-2 dated April, 1971.


