Dear Parents,

We are writing again regarding the allegations surrounding Kevin Lynch's behaviour at St Paul's.

We have been encouraged by the ongoing support for the School throughout its community, and by the obvious concern members of the School family have for each other.

This is vital at a time when continuing media "revelations" are naturally disturbing to us all.

All past students of the School will by Monday have received a letter from us, making it clear again that there was no information or complaint of improper behaviour until the time of Mr Lynch's death.

The continuing support available from the School, and from the Anglican Diocese, for those who have been affected has already been publicly stated and is reaffirmed in that letter.

Some past students have found relief in the publicity which has occurred, but others have expressed their bitter disappointment that the matters are being aired in this way.


Many staff of the School feel a particular burden of betrayal by someone whom they trusted as a colleague.

There are many in our community who will need the ongoing support of us all.

The Diocese of Brisbane has also now published leaflets, which will be available in all Anglican schools, setting out the Church's position on sexual harassment or abuse, and indicating the options available to those who feel they have grounds for complaint. Hopefully the availability of this leaflet will render any future offensive behaviour even less likely.
