PROTECTIVE MEASURES

Counselling room with windows easily viewed from verandah---- at the cost of some privacy for students

Position of counselling rooms adjacent to other work areas----Accounts, Development Office, Community Relations where there is a steady flow of visitors, parents, staff, and students.

The appointment of two counsellors -one male, one female- with adjoining offices.

The development of a Sexual Harassment Policy which is discussed through House groups .

Talks with all Yr 8s at the beginning of the Year re policies on bullying, sexual harassment and abuse. The support structure within the school is detailed.

Heightening of staff awareness and vigilance

Police checks for potential non-teaching staff; Registration with the Board of Teacher Registration has been regarded as adequate for potential teaching staff. Perhaps this should change?

One further note: In addition to the inaccuracies in the description of the room in the press, there was also an internal door into the Science lab next door. This could be opened by staff (with a key) at any time, and Science staff used to pop through to say hello or make a cup of coffee. (This is something **REDACTED** reminded me of today.)
