**Sexuality Education**

In 1992 and 93 Sex Education was included in a semester long unit in year 10, with each class being taught by their PE teacher.

Various themes were covered with the over-riding Christian axiom: "do to others only those things you are happy to have done to you".

Subject matter included:

- Puberty and secondary sexual characteristics male and female
- Male sexual response
- Female sexual response
  - menstrual cycle and pregnancy
- Homosexuality (and homophobia )
- Sexually transmitted diseases - particularly AIDS
- Contraception

Sexual harassment as an issue between boys and girls may have been addressed by 1993 and certainly was in later years..

In each lesson students were given the opportunity to ask questions about anything to do with the subject area.

To the best of my recollection the issue of sexual behaviour of adults towards children was not addressed in any of my classes. It seemed to be a bit of a "taboo" and possibly a threatening topic for some. It may have been the subject of discussion in classes of TMC or SRC.
