Archbishop Aspinall receives Gilbert Case's resignation

The Anglican Archbishop of Brisbane today announced that a separation agreement had been negotiated with Mr Gilbert Case.

Mr Case, Executive Director of the Anglican Schools Office has left his position, effective immediately.

A negotiated settlement was necessary because, as Dr Aspinall has previously stated, Mr Case's current appointment was made despite the diocese being aware of allegations that he did not properly handle abuse complaints while Headmaster at St Paul's School , Bald Hills.

Dr Aspinall will not - as a matter of proper industrial practice - release details of industrial agreements between the diocese and present or former employees. He made it clear that Mr Case was free to discuss the settlement should he choose to do so.
