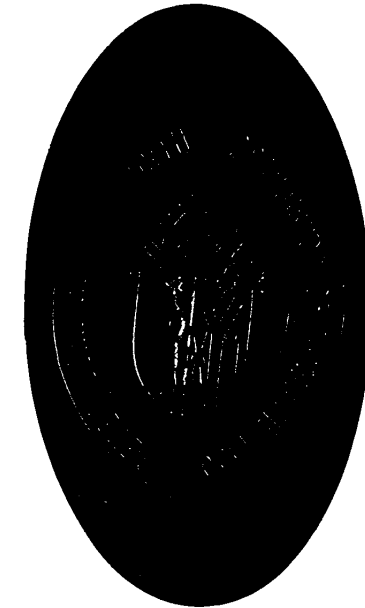
greeting.

We do hereby give and grant to you in whose fidelity morals learning and sound doctrine we do fully confide our authority in accordance with and subject to our powers and prerogatives and the constitution and canons of The Anglican Church of Australia and this our diocese to perform the office of Priest within our diocese and jurisdiction in performing all ecclesiastical duties belonging to the said office according to the rites and ceremonies of The Anglican Church of Australia.

And we do hereby reserve to ourselves and to our successors all powers and authorities dignity and honour appertaining to our spiritual office or vested in us by the said constitution and canons including the power to revoke the said authority at any time.

And we require and direct that you shall not act in your capacity as a Priest in any place without the invitation or approval of the Parish Priest or Chaplain of that place.

In Witness whereof We have caused our Seal which we use in this behalf to be hereto affixed the Second day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and ninety-eight and in the Thirteenth year of our Consecration.
