

(of whose virtuous and pious Life and Conversation, and Competent Learning and Knowledge in the Holy Scriptures we were well assured) into the Holy Order of PRIESTS, according to the manner and form prescribed and used by the Anglican Church of Australia; and him the said JOHN LITTON ELLIOT did then and there rightly and Canonically ordain PRIEST, He having first in our presence made and subscribed such Declarations, and taken and subscribed such Oaths as are by Law in such case required.
