I have had a response from BYK's lawyer that he is happy to deal through the Brisbane Diocese. Can you advise your counterparts in SA and Tas and work out with them how we should progress the issue of coming to an agreement on the amount that we should offer BYK as a settlement. Tas will say a proportion of \$60,000 on the basis that the allegations involving Tas Diocese are not well particularised and most of the abuse took place in Brisbane Diocese. The Archbishop's view is that they should pay whatever is appropriate under their scheme for the abuse that took place in Tas, regardless of the fact that a good deal more abuse took place here. It would be good to get some idea of their respective positions before we meet at 11.00 if that is possible. I will not be in the office before the meeting, hence the email.
