

Thursday 14th March 2002

PA visited [BYF] at Perth Clinic. Arrived around 5.50 pm  
[REDACTED] present initially + left soon after.

A friend of [BYF] [REDACTED] (?) was also present, deputy  
principal of Roman Catholic school in Perth. (3 campuses)  
[BYF] knew [BYF] from S. John's Hamersleyton.  
[BYF] showed both PA + [REDACTED] the letter he had written to  
John Harrower, (Bp of Tas) outlining his experience of abuse  
Letter referred to [BYF] attempts to start conversation about  
those ~~with~~ experiences with + PA. PA didn't pick up w/ves.  
Tasmania understood that as complaint against PA. [BYF] clarified  
with Tasmania that was not his intention.

Dinner in dining room.

Another friend of [BYF]'s arrived and sat through dinner  
but didn't eat [REDACTED]? (CEO of large Youth programme, chair  
of Youth Affairs Council etc) [BYF] originally disclosed abuse to  
this person, member of Baptist Church

PA explained the options open to [BYF] in the Anglican system  
· Police ; · civil action ; · complaints procedure ; · tribunal

PA explained that Daniels may have to be pursued under  
Canberra + Goulbourn system not Tasmania's. That would  
have to be checked.

[BYF] asked about civil action 'Does that mean I sue someone?'  
Yes.

[BYF] : 'so I could sue you. Mm. How much money do you  
have? Your wife's a doctor. You'd have a bit.'

(Talking.)  
[BYF] General affirmation of steps [BYF] had taken. Discussion of how people  
recover from abuse.  
PA and [REDACTED] went for walk to Kings Park.

Discussion continued.

At park discussion included other disclosures of abuse

[BYF] said [REDACTED] had said [REDACTED] was also abused by  
Daniels

[BYF] said [REDACTED] used disclosed abuse by [REDACTED]  
at S. John's Hamersleyton

REDACTED had disclosed to his father REDACTED who hadn't believed it.

REDACTED had made complaint in the Tasmanian system

Discussion about the likelihood of there being many other victims given the concealment evident by Daniels and the opportunities he had over many years through CEBS and Camps in Tasmania.

BYF described some of his experiences in therapy etc

Returned to hospital around 9 pm.

Had cup of tea together in BYF room

REDACTED drove PA back to Wallaroban College c. 9.30pm.
