Around 7 am [BYF] telephoned PA on mobile phone [REDACTED]

[BYF] referred to the joke he'd made on Thursday night about suing PA and how much money PA would have.

[BYF] said that it wasn't a nice thing to say and that he wanted PA to know that he had no intention whatsoever of pursuing a complaint against PA.

[BYF] said he'd been jogged about this by a letter he'd received from John Harrower confirming that [BYF] did not wish to pursue a complaint about PA 'at this stage'.

[BYF] rang ~~contacted~~ to say to PA that he absolutely did not want to pursue a complaint about PA now or ever.

[BYF] said that in his therapy he'd often blamed himself for what had happened. Thought that at his age he should have known better or done something to prevent it. Therapists have said that with his background, life-experience he was relatively naive about abuse and would not have been expected to be able to do anything.

[BYF] said in his view PA was in the same position.

[BYF] said he wanted PA to know that he hadn't done anything wrong and that he was not going to pursue a complaint against PA.

PA thanked [BYF] for the call but also said that [BYF] had to feel entirely free to make a complaint about PA now or in the future if he wished to.

PA said PA wanted it absolutely clear that at no stage had PA tried to dissuade [BYF] from making a complaint about PA if that's what he wanted to do. Nor would PA try to dissuade him.

PA said that as far as PA was concerned the first PA knew of [BYF] abuse was when [BYF] telephoned a few weeks ago. PA had offered support.

[BYF] acknowledged this and reaffirmed that he had no
intention now or ever of making a complaint against PA
PA acknowledged this but said that in 50 years time if
[BYF] changed his mind PA wanted it very clear that
at no stage to PA try to dissuade [BYF] from doing so.
