SC said she had a lot of information that went back years and years on Daniels. Looking back now she can see what was going on.

SC went to Bishop, was a witness to several interviews with boys conducted by the Bishop.

SC: The Bishop undertook to do certain things.

SC doesn't believe he ever did.

SC resigned from church in disgust. Said she said quite a few things in her letter of resignation to the Bp.

PA encouraged SC several times to tell what she knew to the authorities in Tasmania so the matters would be investigated.

SC said she wanted to check with the boys first to see if they were happy for her to follow these things up.

PA said SC could be subpoenaed and required to tell what she knew. PA said in a teaching situation she would be required to report these matters
