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Dear Sue,

I am writing to you in regards to a client of mine who has currently represented for therapy. As your records would indicate I had been meeting with Katherine (Katie) Foster for weekly individual counselling sessions since November 1997 until May 1999. I had been seeing Katie in relation to significant psychological distress associated with alleged childhood sexual abuse by a now deceased and former Parish priest. Sessions ceased prematurely in the context of Katie sustaining significant head injuries after being struck by a motor vehicle.

In recent months I have been recontacted by Katie's mother, Chris Foster, stating that Katie was requesting to meet with me again. After consultation with Katie's neuropsychologist, it became clear that issues related to her abuse history continue to cause significant distress and impact on her day to day life, and it was felt that she required specialist counselling to address this.

Consequently, I met with Katie on the 13/2/02 for an initial assessment meeting. At this stage I propose to meet with Katie to assess the appropriateness of ongoing therapy.

In reviewing my records I noted that therapy sessions had been paid for by CARELINK. I trust that this arrangement is still appropriate and have enclosed an invoice for the meeting of 13/2/02. If you have any queries please feel free to contact me on 9486 3542.
