me the latest report on Gandy.
I agree completely of course
that he should never, in any
circumstances work among
young people. There were
he never works where he
could work with safety: among
the aged, possibly as chaplain
to men in retirement. Not

could still exercise his priest-
hood. I think that hope he
would leave and in fact
has done, under reasonable
conditions with consistent

spiritual direction I believe
it could work — especially
when he has been through
a course of deep, searching
therapy.

I still hope that we shall be
before too long, able to offer
a similar course here in
Australia. I hope to go to
England later this year to
work with the Servants & to
introduce them to the theories
& techniques of Viktor Frankl.
