Plaintiff's date of birth

1984

Commenced Year 6 at Marist College Pearce, halfway through the year

1985 – 1987

The plaintiff was sexually assaulted by Brother Kostka on numerous occasions in his office and during religion class. The plaintiff started heavy binge-drinking on weekends and smoking cigarettes. His grades deteriorated and his behaviour became disruptive, receiving frequent detentions.

1986

The plaintiff started shoplifting and was apprehended by the police. Suspended for one week. Went to court and placed on 12 month good behaviour bond.

1987

The plaintiff's father posted overseas and the plaintiff transferred to REDACTED as a boarder. Developed a bad attitude to schoolwork, teachers and authority, and was removed from sporting teams. Scored poorly in HSC exams.

- 1989 Commenced using cannabis. Smoked four to five joints per night until the age of 35.
- mid 1990 Obtained employment at the REDACTED but later asked to leave by management due to a bad attitude. Then moved to the REDACTED
- July 1991 Commenced an Associate Diploma in Business Management Hospitality but failed to complete despite good marks. Used his father's death in RED as an excuse to not complete.
- 1992 Consulted REDACTED general practitioner, in relation to his hazardous cannabis use.
- 1993 – 1995 Commenced working at the REDACTED located in Canberra. Walked out in the middle of a shift after a disagreement with management after he was caught drinking on the job. Returned to the REDACTED
- 1995 Resided in London for about 10 months. Started using ecstasy, amphetamines and then started to inject amphetamines.
- 1996 – 1997 Returned to Australia and worked in various hospitality positions in Canberra.
- 1997 – 2005 Met his wife and moved to Melbourne. Worked in various hospitality positions in Melbourne and Tasmania.

Nov 2005 - 2007 Obtained employment with the REDACTED
REDACTED dealing in contract management.

Dec 2006 Headhunted by the REDACTED where
his father worked and was well respected as a senior manager,
and REDACTED Disclosed in
security clearance application his history of drug taking. Was not
offered a position.

Aug 2007 – current REDACTED as a human resources
strategist (REDACTED).

26 January 2008 Disclosure of sexual abuse to REDACTE general practitioner
following newspaper article. Not able to get out of bed, flashback,
dreams. Diagnosis – anxiety and possibly some PTSD.
