I assured him that the matter had been taken up properly, that he had been interviewed, that guidelines had been set, that the Headmaster was aware and that I had no reason to believe that there was any problem at all. He was happy with this and would contact Mr. Leo Ryan at [REDACTED] to make an appointment for counselling for himself. He promised to be in touch were there any problems.
