Dear Father.

Thank you for your letter of 15th inst, in reply to my request for information concerning any possible payments to Priests, who because of sexual offences, have been removed from duty, but may possibly receive support through Priests Retirement Foundation.

Believing those offences to be totally abhorrent, I would not support them in any way, and consequently will make our support private to some Priests we know who are retired, and can always use a few \$'s. We will do this by asking them to offer a Mass for special family prayers.

At this point in time we have just discovered that our youngest daughter is leaving her husband and home in ex. Lib. because of what REDACTED states is unacceptable physical punishment given to his eldest daughter (13) in particular, but to a lesser extent also his 11th younger daughter. They and their mother are not blameless. REDACTED is too soft with them, and her husband too harsh. The girls are unfortunately not helping matters by constantly
