Dear Rev. Monsr. Laudmore

There is no doubt you are well and truly sick of the name [REDACTED] [BTM]. You will recall that my wife [REDACTED] and myself brought to your attention a grave matter concerning our son [REDACTED] [BTM] and Fr. Baker. You made it quite clear at a follow up phone call that nothing has been done in this matter, and implied no action would be taken unless [REDACTED] [BTM] was prepared to put his charges of sexual offence in writing. This despite the fact that he totally lost his Catholic faith, and in fact states he cannot believe in God. You may recall you told us in strict confidence of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] who also had similar problems with the same man. If he can be so called. That confidence has not, and will not be dishonoured. [REDACTED] [BTM] now has a second child. Whether will be either baptised or brought up as Christians as far as [REDACTED] [BTM] is concerned. He believes he can do better by them by telling them right from wrong without need of our precious faith. How tragic for all concerned. What a load is placed upon the shoulders of Fr. Baker, and all who either shield or hide him from being legally and spiritually brought to answer to the charges he seems to be able to avoid.

If ever, which is unlikely, [REDACTED] [BTM] can bring himself to unburden his hurt and anger, and come back to a belief in God and His Church, then what Christian future does he have? I know God in His great love and justice will be understanding of [REDACTED] [BTM]'s attitude and

his rejection of God, due to the horrific experiences. How He will judge Fr Baker, may be a totally different event.

We pray constantly for [BTM] a piece of mind, and that one day he will realise that God was not responsible for his pain, and the events that occurred, and will relent and have his family brought up as God would desire it should be. I am afraid [BTM] could never forgive Fr Baker, nor can we. I pray and hope I never personally meet up with the man. I don't know what my reaction would be, but I fear my smouldering anger could erupt like a volcano.

This is probably the last you will hear of this matter from me, unless [BTM] decides to lay charges. It must be admitted that [REDACTED] and myself are quite deluded by the responses we have received.

We know The Church is in a very undesirable position in these days of sexual violation lay Priests and Brothers, and by the wave of "new age" Gnostics and others attempting to take over our traditional faith and develop it along the lines of anti-Pope John Paul II and ^{anti} The Catholic Catechism instructions, and watering down of traditional Catholicism into a milk sop easy going modernist pleasing gutters Church, strongly supported by the unshackled ??? women who want to be Priests. Where will it all end? God may be close to saying enough is enough and terminate humanity;
