Dear Father,

Warning I write this letter to place on formal record the admonition I personally imposed on you in the presence of Father Tom Doyle, on [date] 1993 at the Diocesan Centre. This admonition followed an investigation under my direction in response to allegations of conduct *improper and intemperate against children* ~~against the norms of Canon 1741, #1, #3, #4.~~ [here give a brief and general summary of ~~behaviour~~].

Upon completion of this investigation, I concluded that the conduct has occurred [and has subsequently been admitted by you]. I therefore formally warned you to refrain from the behaviour which brought about these allegations. In virtue of the authority specified in Canon ~~381~~¹³³⁹, #1 and in accord with the provisions of Canon 49, I hereby specifically bind you to the following:

1. [particular conduct to be avoided, or to be mandated]

Should the violation of these directives be verified at some future time, there exists the possibility of a formal examination of your conduct which could result in the imposition of a censure, not excluding suspension; or your removal from the parish.

The reasons motivating these provisions are serious. [Whatever the full truth of the allegations,] in fact scandal has arisen among members of the parish community of KKK.

In accord with Canon 1339, #3, I have directed that a copy of this attestation be placed in the secret archive of the curia and maintained there in accord with the norm of law.
