We, the staff of Holy Family School, Doveton, have signed this letter because we feel that a point has been reached where for the good of the school, some action must be taken. We have supplied to Mr. G. Palmer of the VCPSA a list of grievances and incidents for your consideration. Following legal advice, we prefer Mr. Palmer to mediate in any discussions, but we would individually or collectively be prepared to give personal accounts of the position.

We further declare that as a result of these incidents morale at the school is at a very low ebb and this is having a significant effect on both staff and children. In the long term the aims of the school will be seriously disadvantaged.

As a staff, we are committed to Catholic Education and hold deeply our desire to provide the children of Holy Family School with an effective and happy education. We are unable to do this to the best of our ability under the guidance of the present Parish Priest and implore the Ecclesiastical Authorities to take steps to remedy the situation.
