I would like to draw to your attention the great feeling of unrest in our Parish of the Holy Family, Doveton. Father Seanson has lost all of my respect for various reasons. After visiting the Vicar General two years ago with a group of concerned parents we were told Father Seanson was placed in Doveton because we were a strong community, both spiritually and financially. Unfortunately we are no longer spiritually sound. Several people have already left the Parish and more are threatening to do so.

At a grade 3 mass about a week ago Father said to the children who had a parent present that their parent must love them very much not to go out to work. The children whose parents both worked were obviously saddened by this remark. Unfortunately a lot of families have the need for two incomes. This does not mean they don't love their children.

Two weeks ago I was questioned after picking my children up from school about being behind in the Thanksgiving campaign.

I was told. surely I could afford a mere \$5 per week, many ~~parents~~ people pledge \$10 - \$15 each and every week, obviously they have more faith. Does this mean we measure our faith by the number of dollars we contribute each week?

These are just a couple of my complaints, I have more but I don't think I need write them all. I hope that due to the fact our principle, Mr. G. Stearns, is leaving because of Father and the number of complaints that are coming forward we can have something done.

I do not condemn Father for his actions, because I truly believe he is not responsible for his thoughts or actions.
