I emailed the police and informed them that you had been informed about their request for my file.

I said that the documents would be provided upon a warrant being issued.

Detective Senior Constable Gunther from the SANO taskforce then telephoned me earlier this afternoon and said that they would not issue a warrant unless you wanted to speak to them. I said that you had not indicated that you were either resistant or enthusiastic about speaking to them, simply that you would cooperate if that was required. I offered to pass on to you that the police would like to speak to you if you wished to speak to them. She said that she would be thankful if I would do that.

She indicated that another complainant did come forward, but she said that complaint would not be taken further by the police regardless of whether your file was provided. She did not say why.

As always, my advice to you is that if you want to make a complaint to the police I urge you to do so. Of course, if you do not wish to do so then I do not want to pressure you either way.

Det. Snr. Const Gunther appeared to be a genuine and reasonable person during my brief dealings with her.
