1. Your association and roles held with Geelong Grammar.
2. During the period of your association with the school, your knowledge and understanding of the systems, policies and procedures in place at Geelong Grammar to:
 - a. respond to allegations or complaints of child sexual abuse made at Geelong Grammar;
 - b. prevent child sexual abuse at Geelong Grammar;
 - c. take disciplinary action for staff misconduct;
 - d. ensure staff training takes place on matters concerning child safety;
 - e. report allegations of child sexual abuse (including to the Victorian Institute of Teaching (**Institute**), Victorian police or any other person or body),including, but not limited to, your understanding of those systems, policies and procedures as they related to your role as Principal.
3. Your knowledge of all incidents, allegations or complaints of child sexual abuse occurring at Geelong Grammar and the responses by you or Geelong Grammar to those incidents, allegations or complaints during your period of association with Geelong Grammar.

The above matters are not intended to limit you in any way and you should provide any other information that you consider may be relevant.

We ask that you please provide copies of any documents which record the matters referred to above (unless previously provided to the Royal Commission, in which case the Ringtail reference will suffice).
