1981	President's Report 1981, Honourboard	Bob was the president of RECA between 1981 and 1983
1981	AGM	Bob was re-elected as president of RECA, Bob was elected as the groundsman of RECA, Bob was elected as a representative selector
1981 - 1986	All minutes of meetings and AGMs	Bob continued to be an active member of the RECA. He attended many meetings and completed many odd jobs around the RECA. Bob did not hold any executive positions or any other elected positions at the RECA from 1984 - 1986.
1982	AGM	Bob was re-elected unopposed as president of RECA, Bob was elected as the groundsman of RECA, Bob was elected unopposed as a representative selector
1983	AGM	Bob was not nominated for president of RECA and therefore did not retain this position, Bob was re-elected as groundsman, Bob was not nominated as a selector and therefore did not retain this position.
1984	AGM	Bob was not nominated for any positions
1984	Inaugural Meeting of RJCA	RJCA formed and election of inaugural office bearers conducted. Bob was not nominated for any positions at this meeting.
1984	RJCA meeting 18/5/84	Bob was appointed by RJCA to grade players for fixtures
1984	RJCA meeting 13/8/84	RJCA wrote a letter to Bob to thank him for his efforts in preparing the wicket for the New Zealand Game
1984/85	President's Report 1984/85	Bob was thanked for his work on the grounds of the RECA
1984 - 1987	RECA meeting minutes	Throughout all of the minutes that we have from the RECA from 1984 - 1987, the only position mentioned that was filled by Bob Ross was Coaching Director. The minutes do show a date that Bob was appointed to this position but do not show a date where his involvement with the RECA in this capacity ceased.
1985	RJCA meeting 10/4/85	Bob was requested by RJCA to assist with the presentation of trophies.
1986	RJCA meeting 12/5/86	Bob was approached by RJCA about coaching
1986	RJCA meeting 17/11/86	Bob was appointed as Coaching Director of RJCA
1987	Meeting 23/3/87	Shows that Bob was still assisting with the grounds work.
1987	AGM	Bob was elected as the president of the RECA and as a selector for A Grade.
1987	General meeting 5/10/87	Bob nominated as a REDA Selector
1987	AGM minutes	RECA appointed Bob as Coaching Director
1987/88	AGM RECA 1987, Honourboard	Bob was re-elected as president of RECA for this season
1987/88	AGM 1988 - President's Report	Bob ceased playing and focussed on administrative roles at RECA.
1988	AGM	Bob was nominated as president of RECA but was not elected, Bob was elected unopposed as treasurer of RECA, Bob was elected as A Grade selector for RECA
1988 - 1990	Nil	At some stage during these years The REDA Junior Cricket Association Inc. combined with the RJCA Junior Cricketers to form the REDA Junior Cricket Association.
1988 - 1995	AGM RECA 1988 to 1995, Honourboard	Bob was treasurer of RECA during this time.
1988- 1992	nil	There are no locatable minutes from the RECA during this time.
1989	AGM	Bob was re-elected as treasurer of RECA.
1990	AGM	Bob was re-elected as treasurer of RECA, Bob was elected to be club patron of RECA unopposed.
1991	AGM	Bob was re-elected as Club Patron and treasurer of RECA unopposed.
1991	RECA letter 28/5/91	RJCA sends a letter to Bob (treasurer of RECA) to advise about a cheque that was sent to him.
1991	letter from RECA to NQ 20/4/91	RJCA sends a letter to NQ Coaching Director which names Bob as a local coach.
1991	Letter from Bob to Barry Richards 27/5/91	Bob wrote a letter to Barry Richards (President of the RECA) asking for a cheque to pay for expenses incurred by RECA on behalf of RECA.
1992	AGM	Bob was re-elected as Club Patron and treasurer of RECA unopposed.
1992	Letter from RJCA 20/4/92	RECA sends Bob a letter to congratulate him on receiving life membership of the North Queensland Junior Cricket Association (NQJCA)
1993	AGM	Bob was re-elected as Club Patron and treasurer of RECA unopposed.
1993	RJCA minutes 27/7/93	Bob was elected as Coaching Director for RJCA
1993	RJCA meeting 15/11/1993	A complaint from a parent to RECA regarding children not getting a fair go was resolved at this meeting. Parents who complained were not at the meeting. Bob was not involved.
1993	RJCA meeting 29/11/93	A complaint concerning a supposed breach of rules in Under 12s games was investigated at this meeting. Bob was not involved.
1993/94	RJCA meeting minutes	From all of the documents that we have from RECA from 1993 - 1994, the only position held by Bob was that of Coaching Director in 1993.
1994	AGM	Bob was re-elected as Club Patron and treasurer of RECA unopposed.
1995	AGM	Bob was re-elected as Club Patron and treasurer of RECA unopposed.
1995	RECA general meeting 28/2/1995	Discussed about RECA joining the RECA.
1996	AGM	Bob was nominated for treasurer of RECA but declined. Bob was re-elected unopposed as Club Patron.
1996	Special Meeting of RECA 2/12/1996	RECA and RJCA combine as the [REDACTED] Cricket Association Inc. From our records, the name change did not occur but the union of the two Associations most certainly did.
1997	AGM	Bob was re-elected as Club Patron of RECA
1998	AGM	Bob was re-elected as Club Patron.
1998 - 2000	President's Report 1998 /99 and 1999/2000	Bob Ross and Les Newton conducted raffles on behalf of the RECA at the Commercial Hotel in REDA. This continued well into the 2000s.
1999	AGM	Bob was re-elected as Club Patron of RECA Seniors. George Schultz was elected as Club Patron of the RECA Juniors.
1999 - 2014	Nil	Bob continued to serve as Patron for the RECA seniors until his death in 2014.
Unknown	Rules for Junior cricketers	Bob wrote the rules for junior cricket fixtures. Our estimate is that this happened in the mid-1980s when RJCA first started. The reason for this estimate is that this document was found with the minutes of the meetings that were held at this time.
Unknown	Honourboard	Bob was made a life member of the RECA. Bob is fourth on the list of names of life members on our honourboard. This leads us to believe that life membership was granted to him prior to 1981.
